



STEAM THRESHING JAMBOREE

EXHIBITOR SHOW RULES

1. No equipment is to be left unattended while it is running.
2. All equipment that is equipped with brakes must have operating brakes. Wheels are to be braked when parked or wheels chocked.
3. Properly align equipment when belting to prevent belts from slipping.
4. The operator of any equipment is responsible to ensure that everyone is a safe distance away before starting up equipment.
5. Our insurance carrier requires proof of liability insurance.
6. Operators are to be at least 16 years of age and possess a valid driver's license. The only exception is for those who have completed a safety course at the Jamboree which allows for the driving of tractors in parades and in tractor pulls ONLY.
7. It is recommended that no riders be allowed on any equipment other than those needed to operate the equipment. **Operators assume all responsibility.**
8. Large tractors and steamers should have 2 operators while in motion.
9. All steamers will be allowed to pop off the valve pressure once during the day to check for proper operation and **only once**. This is a safety feature that will be enforced during the show.
10. Gas is to be kept away from flames, sparks, heat and the general public.
11. Each exhibitor should learn / know the location of the nearest fire extinguisher.
12. Machines with sickle bars will have the bar locked so it cannot move. The bar and cutting teeth should be guarded.
13. Alcohol and equipment are a dangerous mix. The use of alcoholic beverages prior to or while operating equipment is not allowed and will not be tolerated.
14. Please keep tractors out of the horse area, and horses out of the tractor area.
15. ALL TRACTORS ARE TO BE SHUT OFF BY 8:00 P.M. The only exception is tractor pull participants at scheduled events.
16. Quiet hours for the Village grounds are from 11:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
17. Exhibitors may load and unload needed supplies near their exhibit, but are then asked to move their vehicle to the parking lot.
18. **Safety comes first! Be Alert – Be Careful – Think before you act.**
