## PRAIRIE VILLAGE CAMPING

Please Note: All electrical camp sites for the 58th Annual Steam Threshing Jamboree August 27-30 are already reserved, but contact us to be placed on the standby list. We accommodate all that come if desire to camp without electricity (Dry Lot). No reservations are required and generators are welcome in the dry lot area. See page 2 for Dry Lot pricing.

General camping is available from Opening Day into mid-October (*weather dependent*) at Prairie Village. We have over 300 sites with electricity, two shower houses and an RV dump station. During operating hours, stop in at the gift shop to register and pay for camping. For after hour arrivals, please use our convenient self-check in station located near the gift shop. Electrical sites - \$21.00 including tax nightly

Non-electrical (Dry Lot) - \$17.00 including tax nightly
