

PRAIRIE VILLAGE JAMBOREE VEHICLE & SAFETY RULES

Our priority is to provide a safe and enjoyable environment for our visitors. To directly assist us in accomplishing that, the following rules apply and will be enforced:

1. **All vehicle operators must know and obey all traffic signs and safety rules while operating allowed vehicles.**
2. Speed limit for all vehicles is 5 MPH. Pedestrians always have right of way.
3. A vehicle pass allowing you to park your vehicle inside the grounds is NOT a permit to operate your vehicle on the show grounds. Due to congestion and safety concerns, vehicles must be parked immediately and remain parked.
4. All vehicles on the show grounds must meet current DOT regulations and be currently licensed and insured. Written proof of insurance may be requested.
5. Vehicle operators must be at least 16 years old and possess a valid driver's license. The only exception is for those under 16 that have completed a Jamboree safety course which allows ONLY the driving of tractors in parades and at tractor pull events.
6. ALL ATVS ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED, as are dirt bikes and motor scooters. Medical scooters are permitted.
7. Golf carts and side by sides are allowed with a \$20 registration fee.
8. All vehicles must have an operational muffler, as well as head and tail lights after dusk.
9. No driving on the grounds after 10:00 p.m. unless departing scheduled events.
10. Vehicle rules violators are subject to having the vehicle towed or otherwise removed from the grounds.
12. NO SMOKING in or near the buildings. NO FIREWORKS on the village grounds. NO campfires allowed without the use of a fire ring.
13. Dogs must be on leashes and under control at all times. Vaccinations must be current and vaccination records producible.
14. Quiet hours on the Village grounds are 11:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.
15. **Parents – you are responsible for the actions of your children!**

EMERGENCY INFORMATION

If illegal, unsafe or disruptive activity is observed, or in the event of an emergency, immediately contact one of the Jamboree staff, security personnel (day 605-212-4129, night 605-610-6793) or call the Lake County Sheriff's dispatch at 256-7615 or 911 as appropriate. The Prairie Village manager, Faron Wahl, can be contacted via cell at 605-360-4011. Faron is also a paramedic.

EMERGENCY FIRST AID can be administered by qualified personnel on the grounds. Primary – Bonnie Nelson: 605-203-0786. The First Aid building is located just east of the old shower house. Note: this building is not always staffed, as EMS personnel are often mobile. Contacts are posted on door.

STORM SHELTERS: New shower house on the E side of the grounds, old shower house SE of the Gift Shop, basement of the Goodwin Church on the S central side of the village (N door), and basement of Dee's house on the W side of the grounds (S door). In Madison: 116 West Center St (enter just west and north of police station - back of armory), and 219 NE 1st St., Public Safety Building basement (Courthouse N side).
