



# Grounds Safety Rules

## Steam Threshing Jamboree v. 1.1

### **Pets:**

- Pets must be on a physical leash while on Prairie Village property, including within the pet owner's immediate campsite. Excessive barking / noise must be controlled.
- Pets must be kept under control and owners must pick up after them.
- All appropriate immunizations must be current and documented.
- Pets are not allowed inside buildings (except documented service animals).

### **Driving / Motorized vehicles:**

- ATVs/4-wheelers and motor scooters are prohibited. Medical scooters are allowed. Golf carts and gators/side-by-sides are allowed with paid registration and issued tag visible.
- All vehicles must operate with headlights after dusk.
- Motorized units of any type may only be operated by a currently licensed driver at least 16 years old (only exception is driving in parades and on the tractor pull track - only after completing annual Jamboree driving safety course).
- Operator may not drive while consuming alcohol or while under the influence of alcohol. Speed limit for all vehicles is 5 MPH.
- All vehicles must remain on established roads within the immediate historic building and camping areas. All other areas (including RR right of way) are prohibited.
- Campers' personal vehicles may not be parked on/in other campsites, even if vacant.
- Drone flying is prohibited on PV property without express written approval.

### **Buildings:**

- Children under 16 are not allowed in buildings unless accompanied by a parent/guardian or another responsible adult.

### **Smoking / campfires / fireworks:**

- No smoking is allowed inside or within 25 feet of buildings.
- All campfires must be contained in an appropriate containment device, be monitored in person, and be put out thoroughly before departing. You are responsible for any campfire you light.
- Absolutely no fireworks are allowed on PV property.

**Quiet hours:** Quiet hours are 11:00 pm through 9:00 am daily.
